



The Club Forbes Team is pleased to announce Club Forbes will be reopening at **10am on Wednesday 1st July 2020.**

The Club Forbes Team have been working hard to prepare the venue to be CovidSafe, with lots of cleaning being undertaken over the past weeks and our kitchen under renovation.

Upon entering Club Forbes, we ask you to be prepared for changes that are not only required under NSW Health legislation but are also the requirements of the Club Forbes CovidSafe plan.

1. No admittance to persons with flu like symptoms.
2. Hand Sanitising upon entry.
3. Entry requirements - Signing in at the time of entry including Club Forbes Members.
4. Exit requirements - Signing out at the time of departure including Club Forbes Members.
5. The number of people allowed inside Club Forbes will be determined by the 'one person per 4 square metre' rule, with no upper limit. All activity must be seated only.
6. Practicing Social distancing of 1.5m between each person.
7. Changed process to food and beverage ordering and service.
8. Group bookings not exceeding 20 persons including meetings. Meeting room availability will be subject to Covid-19 restrictions at the time and therefore may not be available.
9. No commingling in groups or standing. Patrons including children must remain seated with the exception of ordering food/beverage or using the facilities.
10. Reduced activities that would attract large numbers that would exceed the 1 person per 4m² rule.
11. Follow and respect the signage throughout the Club in order to ensure Club Forbes manages the CovidSafe principles.
12. The following non-essential activities will be suspended until further notice, including but not limited to; Bingo, Raffles, Poker, Live Entertainment/Shows, Group Meetings, private functions.

Persons entering the Club will be required to complicity follow all directives from Club Forbes Team Members. Remember whatever the changes, we are doing them for the benefit of you and our staff. Staff deserve to be able to come to work and work in a safe workplace and patrons deserve to be able to relax in a safe environment.

Club Forbes Board of Directors, Management and its Staff reserve right to refuse entry to any person with flu like symptoms or does not complicity follow all directives from Club Forbes Team Members. Any patron refusing to comply with a Club Forbes Team Member directive, will be asked to leave the premises.

The Club Forbes Team looks forward to welcoming everyone back. We ask for your patience whilst Club Forbes starts to rebuild and become financially stronger. This will not happen over-night and Club Forbes will need the support of its members and the Forbes Community during these unprecedented times.
